



Witnessing Daily About our Resurrected Lord

Recently, while outside the parsonage getting prepared to attend a Sunday early worship service one of my neighbors came across to talk. He shared with me about his new life in Christ and how excited he was about his changed perspective about living. His resurrection experience came about when he surrendered to the love and grace of God while rejecting those creature comforts of wealth and self-love. God removed all those things that once defined him, while offering new opportunities that blessed him and his family. His Christian testimony challenged my trust

and encouraged my witness in Jesus Christ.

In our worship we too must see the resurrected Lord in all that we are and do. Many times we use the liturgical calendar as our guide in planning worship together as United Methodists. On first Sundays we share communion at the Lord's Table. At this table we remember the immeasurable and precious gift of the love of God though the body and blood of the crucified and resurrected Jesus Christ. Here we are fed, encouraged, healed, nurtured, and as well as sealed by the Holy Spirit to live out our stories of faith until the rule of God is fully established on the earth.

For the remainder of the month of May, in our liturgy let us recognize the resurrected Lord's presence and power in the celebration with mothers and motherly figures during mother's day. We are reminded for example, "Do not despise your elderly mother" in Proverbs 23:22. Let us endeavor to embrace grieving, happy, lonely, struggling and weary women of God and all category of mothers with words and acts of love and respect as community. The third Sunday in May, our liturgy will remind us of our apostolic and evangelical Christian heritage. The community of faith called Methodists placed among the wider witness of the Church is to live out our discipleship in words and deeds of love. Christian witness of the love of God that is good news brings renewal to communities. Then we look to the last Sunday in May, Ascension Sunday which falls on Memorial Day weekend. As Christ Jesus was preparing to ascend to heaven, these words were left for the disciples and today's church. "You are witnesses of these things." (Luke 24:48). Resurrection is not just the promise of new life, it is available life now in Christ Jesus.

Let us continue the Easter experience by living this new life in Christ in our daily encounters. We are empowered to live out our stories as witnesses. As was done to the disciples (apostles) Jesus, "lifted his hands and blessed" us, and thereby commissioning all of the faithful to display our faith in God to all persons. May you have a blessed month as witnesses of Christ Jesus.
