

A theme that is a guiding focus on Black History Month is *BLACK MIGRATION*. Black migration is worldwide. Black persons migrating from Africa and the Caribbean are among the "new" African American population in the United States. Migration of Black people is a gift to the multi-layered kaleidoscope of this nation and contributing positively to the development and well-being of this nation. Black migrants are also subject to racial suburbanization, health and environmental challenges, gentrification of communities, social conflicts, educational challenges and employment/economic hurdles.

So, I ask myself, what can we observe in Black History month and beyond that can be meaningful and empowering to all of us? My imperfect answer is the heritage of faith. As people of the Americas and as Christians, I believe we carry the heritage of faith in our stories of migration. We can share our faith that generates hope of a better day for our children to enter into the "promise land" of opportunity and peace. A general biblical look at heritage is related in the word inheritance. In the first or Old Testament, an inheritance was legalistic "to possess as having handed down (some property or legacy) from the past." (Numbers 27:1-11). It may be handed down from fathers or more so gifted by God (Interpreters Dictionary of the Bible). The people of God are on a journey to a "place of rest" (Deuteronomy 12:9-10) where, in God, their full heritage is located. The people of Israel regarded themselves as God's heritage (Psalm 79:1; Jeremiah 10:16).

In the New Testament, the theological significance of faith heritage is reflected through the Apostle Paul. In Romans 4:16 he writes, "...the inheritance comes through faith, so that it will be on the basis of God's grace. In that way, the promise is secure for all..." In the epistle to the Colossians 1:12-13, connecting God's inheritance with "light given to holy people." Later, in this same writing, he note that this inheritance is obtained through practice of spiritual discipline (obedience, CEB) who serve the Lord Christ (3:24). In the letter of Hebrews in Chapter 6, this journey of faith leads to destination of salvation and takes discipline and effort. "This is so you won't be lazy, but follow the example of the ones who inherit the promises through faith and patience" (Hebrews 6:12).

Some thoughts for our journey using a heritage of faith affirms God's hand in our lives. Our journey with God together is a gift that we can pass on to the next generation. In sharing our giftedness, we must work for fairness and justice for all people, pass on cultural and practical knowledge, and display discipline of holding each other accountable to live holy lives.




